GUIDELINES AND RULES REVIEWED

The FAMS Mathematics Team should consist of at least 8 students on any grade level plus 2 alternates. Any number of students may take each examination. Additional copies of the contest may be made on the same day prior to administration as needed. Only the TOP 8 scoring students will be reported to the association and they need not be the same 8 students each time.

The ENTIRE TEAM is to have exactly thirty-five (35) minutes to do the contest examination. CALCULATORS may be used but not shared by students. After the test, Mr. Snee will score the answer sheet. A monthly newsletter will be sent to all schools with the contests results, per cent correct for each question and the average score for the exams.

Unique, insightful, and interesting alternate solutions to the problems are welcome. The association will publish the name of the student and the school along with the solution in the resulting newsletter. We will also publish the top-scoring students on our web site after the third contest.

Highest-scoring students will win an award.
